The scholarship recipients should be interested in the promotion and harmony and understanding among various diverse cultures which exist in the City of Emporia, the State of Kansas, and the United States of America as exemplified in the lives of Thomas E. Bonner and Mary W. Bonner and reflected in the Bonner & Bonner Diversity Lecture Series now at Emporia State University.

Conditions for the scholarship are as follows:

- The Bonner and Bonner Scholarship shall be awarded to students who has an economic need and/or is from an underrepresented group.
- The Bonner and Bonner Scholarship will be awarded to a new student that pursues course work in Economics, Mathematics or Mathematics Education

Applicants must submit a letter of application by February 23rd, 2016. The letter should include each of the following items:

1. Your prospective major in Economics, Mathematics or Mathematics Education and...
2. A brief essay on why you feel you should receive The Bonner and Bonner Scholarships.
3. A brief bio of yourself.
